Helping the Russians Help the Russians

Micaiah Ministries has a twenty-year history in Russia ministering to people from every walk of life. We've ministered in churches, crusades, leadership conferences, youth camps, hospitals, care centers, orphanages, on the streets and in homes.

During the past twenty years we have had the privilege to participate in community activities with local dignitaries and our work with youth in crisis has received positive attention with exposure to the public through local media including television news reports.

When Ron and Jill Stafford, former directors of Victory Bible College – Tulsa, OK, invited us to Russia, our intention was to be a blessing to the missionaries and

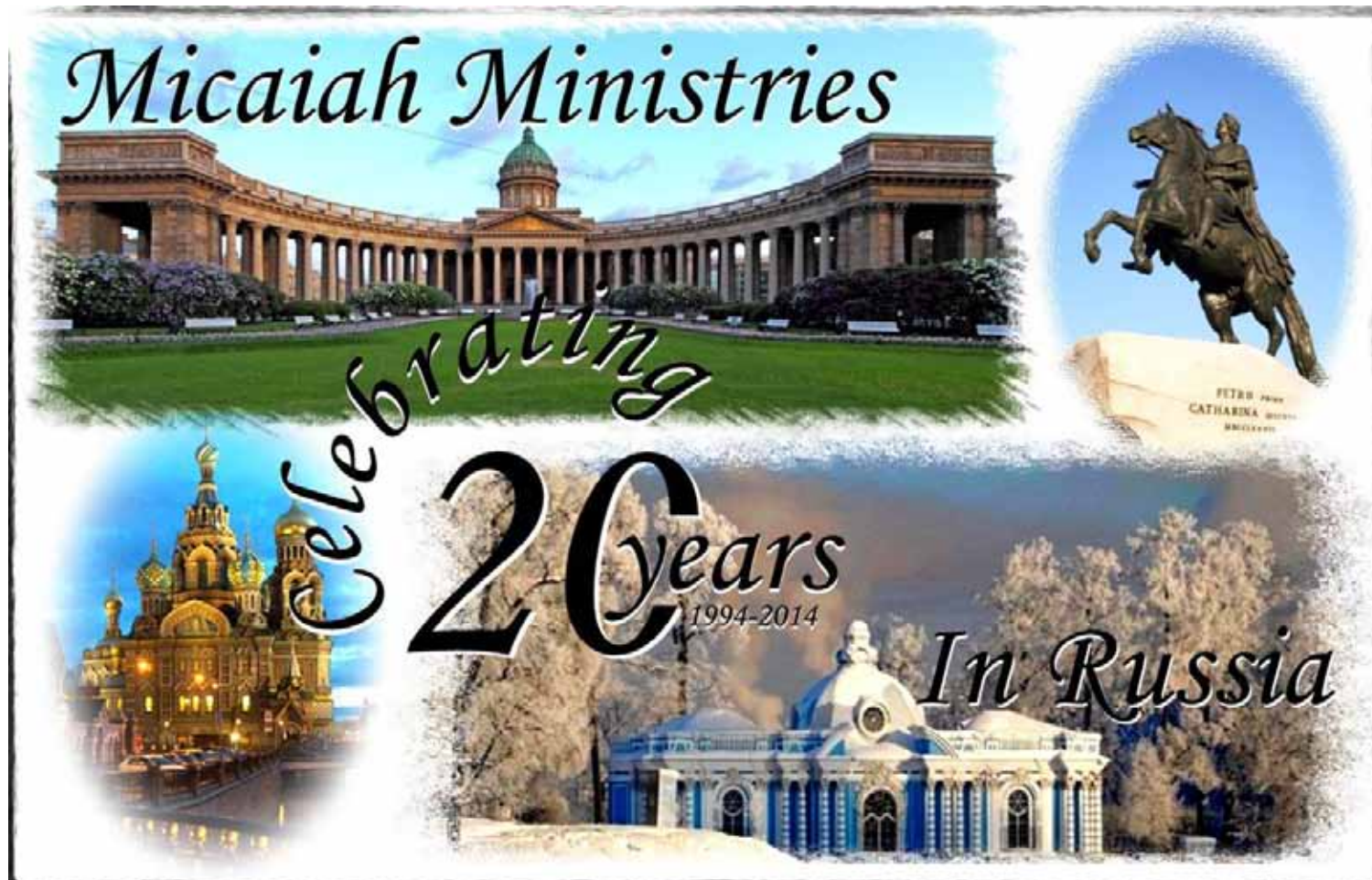


the people of the former Soviet Union. But, we had no idea we would have such a strong presence

there today.

During that first visit we sensed the prompting of God to **"Help the Russians help the Russians."** We started by doing little things like helping to deliver canned goods to those in need. Although what we did seemed small and insignificant, we embraced the words of Zechariah "Do not despise these small beginnings, for the LORD rejoices to see the work begin..." (Zechariah 4:10 NLT)

I think that I can say that although we had clear direction to return to Russia just five months after our first visit, we had no idea the extent of what God had actually





called us to. In August of 1994 we took our first ministry team to hold crusades and minister in churches.

We would return again in March 1995 to assist missionaries and teach in the Bible school and churches. In the summer of that year we did our first youth trip to Russia. We traveled throughout Saint Petersburg alongside the Victory youth drama team and then traveled to Ivanova to hold a crusade that attracted more than 1200 people and helped to birth a church in that city.

If space would allow, much could be said about the years that would follow.

During that time God was building relationships between many pastors and us. Soon we began to realize the tremendous need for fellowship, encouragement and training for leaders. In 2001 we conducted the first of many Leadership Conferences.

During one of the first Conferences Olga Chigireva, the children's pastor at Victory, brought to our attention the crisis of youth living on the streets when

she introduced us to Valodia, a young man who asked for prayer to have a "normal life."

He had alcoholic parents who abused him and turned him out into the streets to beg. He told us that he was cold, hungry and afraid. As we prayed, we were reminded of James 2:16, "And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit?" and the vision and work of Restoration House was birthed.

In 2006 the first property and building were purchased and reconstructed to accommodate staff and youth. It was obvious from the start that we were quickly outgrowing present living conditions. Within two years there was an addition built enlarging the living room, adding two bedrooms and a much larger bathroom.

With the growing need to

find ways to help young ladies in crisis, in 2010 we built "Little Sister." Most recently we enlarged the dining room and kitchen in the main house and added another bedroom on the second floor.

Although we are celebrating the accomplishments of our partners who made it possible to do all that has been done, the work has not ended.

The vision to purchase more property, build more housing and facilities to enable us to minister to youth in crisis, to "Help Russians help the Russians," is as strong in us today as it was from the beginning.

We rejoice in what God has done the past 20 years and we look forward in anticipation to what He will do in the years to follow.

Together, we ARE making a difference...
Together, we ARE reaching the world for Jesus!
